ORDER

Dated: Nalbari, the 16th of March, 2020.

In view of Hon'ble Gauhati High Court's direction vide Order No. 11 dated 15.03.2020 and Notification dated 15.03.2020 and in terms of directions issued by the Government of India, the following steps have been taken as precautionary measures for prevention and spread of **Novel Corona Virus (COVID-19)** disease:-

1. Only urgent matters will be taken up by all the Courts and the rest matters will be adjourned.
2. Learned Counsels are requested to submit the list of urgent matters to the bench Assistants of each Court.
3. There will be restrictions in the entry of public in the Court campus and Court room to avoid and curtail the gathering of people in the Court campus and Court rooms. Only litigants whose personal appearance is inevitable will be allowed to enter the Court campus and Court room.
4. All the U.T.P s will be taken up through video conferencing except the cases which are at the stage of judgment and Presiding Officers of all the Courts are requested to ensure the video conferencing of the U.T.P s for welfare and safety of all as a precautionary measure. The Systems officer and Systems Assistant will ensure the same.
5. As far as possible the recording of evidence of I.O and M.O and experts be recorded through video conferencing for the safety of all as a precautionary measure.
6. Learned Counsels are requested to submit written arguments as far as possible for the safety and welfare of all.
7. The Joint Director of Health Services, Nalbari, and the District Administration will be requested to provide para-medical staff for medical screening of the Public/Litigants/Officers/Learned Advocates/Court staff etc. coming to the Court campus for the safety and welfare of all.
8. The Court Manager, In-charge Chief Administrative Officer and the Accounts Asstt. will take immediate steps to procure hand sanitizer, disinfectant and will supply to all the Officers/staff etc. for safety and welfare of all.
9. Learned President and Secretary of Nalbari Bar Association is requested to ensure less gathering in the Bar and to provide sanitizers for greater welfare and safety of the public.
10. Mask N – 95, gloves will be provided to all the Safai Karmacharis and Court staffs for the safety and welfare of all.

11. Court staffs will take steps to disinfectant and sanitize the Court rooms and the Court Manager, In-charge Chief Administrative Officer, Sheristadars, Accounts Asstt. and the team members will ensure the cleanliness of the Court rooms and Court campus.
12. As far as possible the entry of outsiders will be restricted. Entry of Foreign Nationals is totally prohibited.
Inform all concerned accordingly.
