ORDER No.- 136

Dated: Nalbari, the 30th April, 2021

It has come to the knowledge of the undersigned that Covid-19 positive cases has been detected amongst the members of the Nalbari Bar. Hence, to protect the life and limb of the learned advocates, litigants, staffs and judicial officers, the following measures are taken in compliance with Disaster Management Act, The Epidemic Disaster Act, guidelines of Central Govt. & State Govt. and Hon'ble Gauhati High Court guideline relating to Covid-19 protocol to contain the spread of Covid-19 disease.

1. In view of the recent surge in cases of Covid-19 disease in the district of Nalbari, learned President/Secretary of Nalbari Bar is requested to ensure that there will be no gathering in and around the Bar and to provide sanitizers for greater welfare and safety of all. The learned President/Secretary of the Nalbari bar is further requested that as and when cases of covid-19 positive is found amongst the bar members, the bar should be closed and sanitized and not open till contact tracing is completed as per covid-19 protocol.
2. Entry of outsiders will be strictly prohibited in the court premises. The learned Advocates and parties who are appearing in person as per clause (vii) of Hon'ble Gauhati High Court's Notification No-28 dated 19.04.2021 shall be permitted in the court room on production of valid covid 19 negative test result.
3. The Entry of advocates are restricted except the advocates whose case is fixed as per clause (vii) of Hon'ble Gauhati High Court's Notification No-28 dated 19.04.2021, on production of covid-19 negative test report, not older than 48 hours.
4. All the court will take up urgent matters through Video Conferencing except recording of statement u/s 164 and 313 of the Cr.P.C, bail matters, Zimma matters, and temporary injunction matters, remand matters, etc. in physical form in staggered manner. Learned judicial officer shall take up the bail bond through video conferencing of all the courts where bail has been granted.

5. Learned advocates who prefer to come to the court for arguing their cases from the courts, if they have no sufficient infrastructure of their own shall inform the court in email of the respective courts (See Order No. 125 & 126 dated 22nd April, 2021)
6. Along with bail bond, relevant documents and the certificate of the identifier advocate of the bailor/surety that all the copies of the documents were true copy of the documents shall be submitted through e-mail in pdf format in the respective court email ids.
7. While filling the new cases/at the time of receiving the ready copy learned advocate shall maintain social distancing in the filling counter and wearing face mask and sanitizing hands properly.
8. Only one filling advocate at a time shall be allowed to enter the court premises to maintain social distancing and to avoid gathering of more than 5 persons.
